Recent Events:

- Officers responded to 5,547 incidents and wrote 302 arrest citations in the month of July.

-Officers responded to Cambridge Square Apartment for a burglary. Known suspects enter the residence without permission and assaulted the victim. The subjects fled out the rear of the apartment, while fleeing one subject fired multiple rounds from a firearm striking the building. Investigation is ongoing.

-Officers responded to Tibbats reference a stolen golf car. The golf cart was located after striking a vehicle on E 16th Street. The juvenile suspects were taken into custody, charged, and released to their guardians.

-Officers responded to area of W 34th with the fire department in reference to an explosive ordnance laying in the grass. Cincinnati Bomb Squad responded and secured the ordnance.

-Officers responded to Sole by Style for report of a theft. Unknown subjects wearing ski masks entered the store and stole \$1700 worth of merchandise. The investigation is ongoing.

-Detectives and the Northern Kentucky Drug Strike Force served multiple search warrants at various locations. The warrants produced large amounts of narcotics and cash.

-Officers responded for a shooting on Mable Street. Known subjects exchanged gunfire with one party being struck. They were transported to the hospital for non-life threatening injuries.

-Officers have taken several reports of catalytic convertor thefts. Most of the thefts are occurring in Latonia and the south end. Please be aware and call for any suspicious subjects or vehicles, especially at night.

Other News:

-Officer Sinacori was sworn in and will be starting the academy this month.

-Please welcome our new Community Liaison Officer, Specialist Birkley, she is taking the place of Officer Haubner who was promoted to Sergeant. Specialist Birkley has been with Covington for 4 years and will be working alongside Specialist White. - Covington PD Bookworms is having another event. It will take place August 11th from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm at Austinburg Park. This is a great event to meet and spend time with Officers. Officers will be handing out reading and activity/work books, ages infant to young adult.

Helpful Tips:

The City has amended the Noise Control Ordinance 92.07. The full ordinance can be located on the City's website.

Key sections:

-Excessive noise prohibited between the hours of 8:00 am and 10:00 pm Sunday through Thursday, and 8:00 am to 11:00 pm Friday through Saturday from at least 100 feet from public or private property.

-Excessive noise prohibited between the hours of 10:00 pm to 8:00 beginning Sunday night to Friday morning and 11:00 pm to 8:00 am from Friday night to Sunday morning from at least 25 feet from public or private property.

-Exemptions include construction between 7:00 am to 6:00 pm, sounds from emergency equipment, and recreation/festivals/special events approved by the City.

-Violations carry a \$50 fine for a first offense, a \$100 fine for a second, and a \$150 fine for every offense after.
